Vest "Bordoy"

Design: Irene Lindörfer



Size: 36/38 (40/42) 44/46



Materials: "Oxford" (100% wool, yardage = 90 m (99 yds.)/300 g), color: 900 g (900 g) 1200 g "Grey-Mélange-Anthracite" #9755, knitting needles 15 mm (US 19), crochet hook 15 mm (P/Q)

2/2 rib pattern: RS rows: Alternate k2, p2; WS rows: knit sts as they appear.

Stockinette stitch: RS = knit, WS = purl

Garter stitch: RS knit, WS knit.

Stockinette stitch



Gauge stockinette stitch with needle 15 mm (US 19)

5 sts and 7 rows = 10×10 cm (4")

Stitch counter x 0.5
Row counter x 0.7

Stitch counter x 0.5
Row counter x 0.7

Back:

- **I.** CO 32 (34) 36 sts and knit in rib pattern in rows. Start with the a WS row with edge st, p2, k2 (k1, p2) k2, p2 and end with k2, p2 (p2, k1) p2, k2, edge st.
- 2. After 6 cm (2 ¼") in rib pattern continue in stockinette stitch.
- **3.** After 34 cm (13 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") from rib pattern BO 1 st on both sides for the armholes. In the 2nd row BO 1 st on both sides once = 28 (30) 32 sts.
- **4.** After 20 (21) 22 cm ($7 \frac{3}{4}$ " (8 $\frac{1}{4}$ ") 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") from the beginning of the armholes BO the remaining 28 (30) 32 sts.

Right front:

- **1.** CO 16 (17) 18 sts and knit in rib pattern in rows. Start with the a WS row with edge st, k1, p2 (k2, p2), p1, k2 and end with k2, p1, edge st.
- 2. After 6 cm (2 ¼") in rib pattern continue in stockinette stitch.
- **3.** After 28 cm (II") from rib pattern BO I st on the left side of work for the armhole. In the 2nd row BO I st once = 14 (15) 16 sts.
- **4.** After 17 (18) 19 cm (6 $\frac{3}{4}$ ") (7") 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") from the beginning of the armholes BO 6 (7) 7 sts on the right side of work for the neckline.
- **5.** After 20 (21) 22 cm ($7 \frac{3}{4}$ " (8 $\frac{1}{4}$ ") 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") from the beginning of the armholes BO the remaining 8 (8) 9 sts.

Left front:

Mirror the pattern and work the same as the right front.

Finishing:

Block pieces and leave under wet towels to dry.

Close shoulder and side seams. Bear in mind that the back is 6 cm (2 $\frac{1}{4}$ ") longer than the front pieces. The hem of the back sticks out. Pick up 24 (28) 28 sts from the neckline for the collar. Knit 5 cm (2") in garter stitch, then BO all sts. Crochet 1 row or 1 rd of sc sts around the straight edges of the fronts and the armholes.

Weave in all ends.


