



Lace pattern

## Sizes: 36-38 (US 8-10), 40-42 (US 12-14)



**Yarn: 200 gm** Color 1878 ombre or 200 gm Color 1873 ''Gradient'' (100% Merino, length 260m/100gm)


Needles: 3.5mm circular needles, each 80 long

**Special abbreviations: 1x1 Rib – worked in rounds:** (K1, p1) rep throughout. **St st – Stockinette Stitch in the round:** Knit throughout.

**Tension:** 25 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm, measured over St st using 3.5 mm needles.

## Skirt:(worked in rounds)

Using 3.5 circular needles cast on 200 (224) sts. Work 20 rounds in I  $\times$  I Rib. Beg with a knit row, cont in St st to 30 cm. Work a further 20 rounds in I  $\times$  I Rib. Cast off.



## Abbreviations

	1 · · · ·
beg	= beginning

- cont = continue/continuously
- k = knit
- p = purl
- rep = repeat
- rib = ribbing
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- St st = Stockinette stitch (UK: stocking stitch)
