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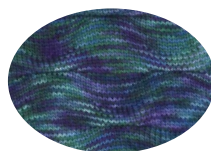
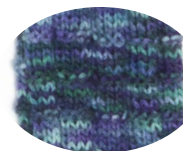
Poncho Gimme more green

Design: Anna-Maria Busch

**Size: 36/38 (40/42)****Materials: 400 g (400 g) "6 KARAT"**(80% virgin wool (extrafine), 20% silk,
yardage= 600 m (656 yds.)/100 g), color:**"Gimme more green" #2235**, knitting
needles 2 mm (US 0) and 2.5 mm (US 1½)**Stockinette stitch:** RS knit, WS purl.**Rib pattern:** Alternate k1, p1; in WS rows knit sts as they appear.**Basic pattern A:** See chart A. Number of sts: multiple of 24 + 17 sts.

Read the RS rows from right to left, the WS rows stated in the chart from left to right. In WS rows not given in the chart, knit the sts as they appear. Start with 4 sts before pattern repeat, continually work the 24 sts of the pattern repeat, ending with 13 sts after the pattern repeat. Repeat rows 1- 40 for pattern.

Basic pattern B: See chart B. Number of sts: multiple of 6 +6 + 2 edge sts. Read the RS rows from right to left, the WS rows stated in the chart from left to right. In WS rows not given in the chart the sts are knitted as they appear. Start with the 6 sts before pattern repeat, continually work the 6 sts of the pattern repeat, ending with the 2 sts after the pattern repeat. Repeat rows 1 - 6 for pattern.

Basic pattern A**Basic pattern B****Gauge:****In basic pattern A with needle 2.5 mm (US 1½):**

30 sts and 50 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4")

In basic pattern B with needle 2.5 mm (US 1½):

34 sts and 40 rows (slightly stretched) = 10 x 10 cm (4")

Stitch counter x 3.0 or 3.4**Row counter x 5.0 or 4.0****Back:**

1. With needle 2.5 mm (US 1½) CO 139 (163) sts and knit in st st for 2.5 cm (1").

2. For the bottom border on the left edge, CO 13 new sts and continue with the sts divided as follows: Edge st, 137 (163) sts in st st, 13 sts in rib pattern, edge st = 152 (176) sts.

After 2.5 cm (1") begin basic pattern A and continue with the sts divided as follows: Edge st, 137 (163) sts in basic pattern A, working the pattern repeat 5 (6) times in each row, 13 sts rib pattern, edge st.

After 75 cm/29½" (80 cm/31½") from CO edge BO all sts.

Front:

Work the same as the back but with the bottom border on the right edge.

After 2.5 cm (1") CO 13 new sts on the right edge.

Sleeves:

3. With needle 2.5 mm (US 1½) CO 62 (74) sts and purl the 1st WS row. Continue in basic pattern B, working the pattern repeat 9 (11) times in each row. After 25 cm (10") from CO edge BO all sts loosely.

Work the 2nd sleeve the same as the 1st.

Finishing:

Block pieces and leave under wet towels to dry.

On the front and back piece fold the bottom border at the CO edges 2.5 cm (1") to the inside and sew in place. Sew the BO edges of the front and back together. Close the upper seam, leaving an opening of 25 cm (10") on the right edge for the neckline.

With needle 2 mm (US 0) CO 16 sts for the border and knit in rib pattern for 50 cm (19¾"). BO all sts.

Place the neck band, right sides facing, on the neckline and sew in place.

Fold the band to the inside and sew the 2nd long side to the inside. The neck band is invisible from the outside.

Close the sleeve seams and set in sleeves according to the diagram.

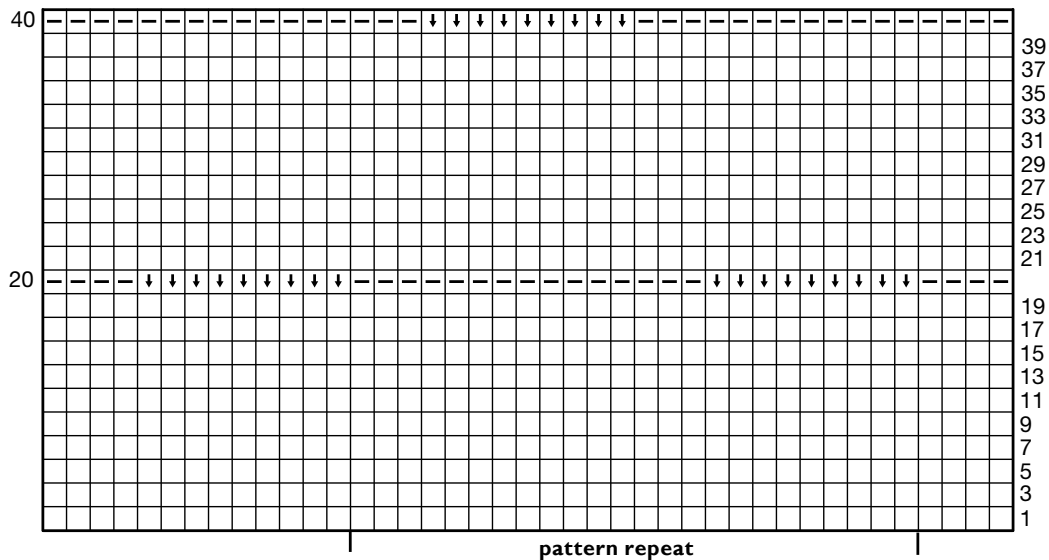
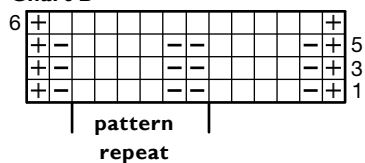


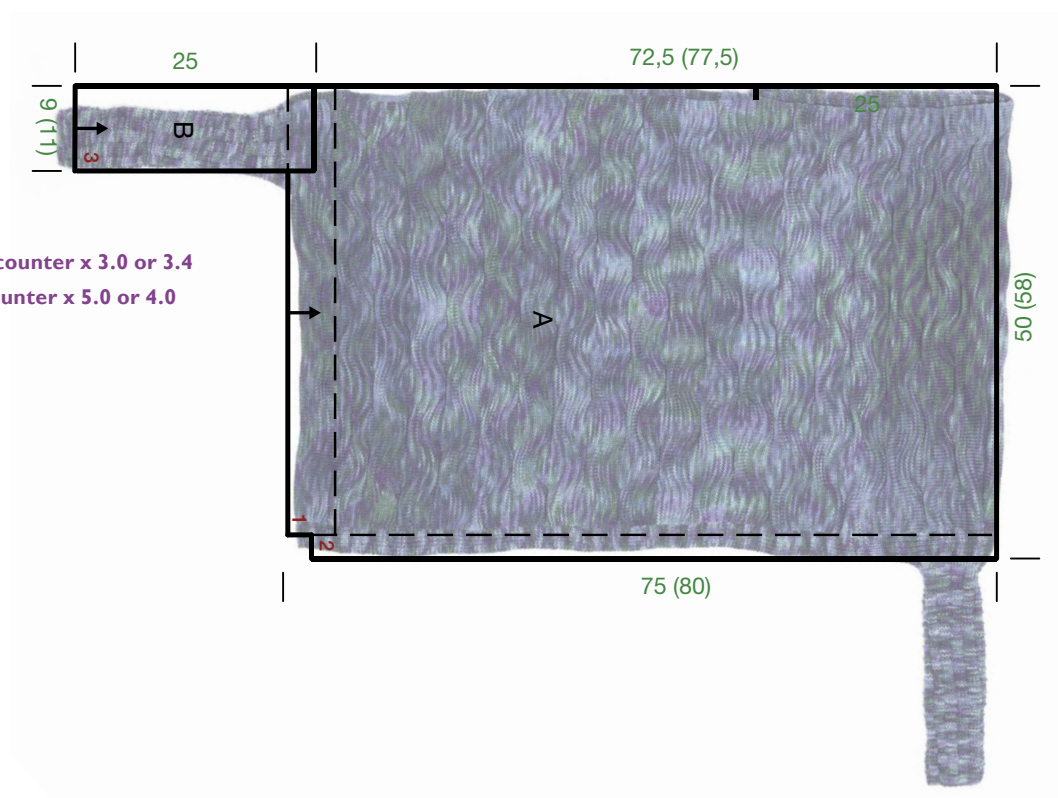

- = With the right needle, lift 1 st from 7 rows below on the left needle and purl 2 sts together

Row counter x 5.0 or 4.0
