

Mitts

Design: Jutta Hinrichs



Finished mitts measure: 9.5 cm by 31 cm.



Yarn: 100 gm Color 2175 "Single Disk" (75 % Wool, 25 % Polyamid, length 420 m/100 gm). Needles: One set double pointed needles 2.5 mm - 3 mm, 20 cm long; Markers.

Special abbreviations: St st - Stockinette Stitch worked in rounds: K throughout. 2 x 2 Rib: * K2, p2, rep from * throughout. Tension: 30 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm, measured over St st using 3 mm needles.

Mitts (both alike): Using 3mm double pointed needles cast on

64 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 4 needles = 16-16-16 sts. Join for working in rounds, being careful not to twist sts. Beg with Round 1 of rib, work 8 rounds. Beg with a knit round, cont in St st to 20 cm from cast-on sts. Thumb Gusset: Next Round: Knit to the last st of 3rd needle, place marker, m1, knit last st on 3rd needle, knit first st on 4th needle, ml, place marker. Next Round: Knit to 1st marker, slip marker, ml, k4, ml, slip marker, knit to end. Rep incs between markers as set in every foll 7 alt rows = 20 sts between markers. **Next Round:** Knit to 1st marker, slip next 20 sts onto a holder, cast on 2 sts, knit to end = 64 sts. Work a further 4 rounds. Cont in rib, work 6 rounds. Cast off. **Thumb:** Slip 20 sts from Thumb Gusset onto a double-pointed needle, with RS facing, rejoin yarn and knit across 20 sts, pick up and knit 2 sts from cast on sts of opening = 22 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, cont as folls: **Next Round:** k 18, k2tog, k2tog = 20 sts. Cont in rib, work 6 rounds. Cast off.

alt = alternate = beginning beg

= continue/continuously cont foll(s) = following(follows) inc(s) = increase(s)/increasing

= knit

= knit 2 together k2tog = Make I stitch ml

= purl р = repeat rep = ribbing rib RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es)

= Stockinette stitch (UK: stocking stitch) St st
