

Basic pattern



Gauge in pattern with needle 4.5mm (US 7):

23 sts and 22 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm } (4")$

Stitch counter x 2.3

Row counter x 2.2

Instructions:

CO 103 sts with needle 4.5 mm (US 7) and work in pattern. After approx. 200 cm (79") from CO edge (= Row 15 of the pattern), BO all sts loosely.

Finishing:

Wash the wrap and block the piece. Leave under wet towels to dry.

Difficulty

Abbreviations

ВО = bind of CO = cast on = knit = purl Р RS = right side st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side

Size: ca. 45 x 200 cm (17 3/4" x 79")



Materials: Lace Ball 100 (100% merino wool superwash, yardage = 800 m (875 yds.)/ 100 g), 100 g color: "Light in the Tunnel" #2264, lace knitting needles 4.5 mm (US 7).

Garter stitch in rows: RS knit, WS knit.

Pattern: Knit in rows.

Number of sts: multiple of 16 + 7 sts. Rows I - 3: Knit in garter st in rows.

Row 4: K7, * BO 9 sts (I knitted st is already on the nd), k6, repeat from * 5 more times.

Row 5: K7, # CO 9 sts, k7, repeat from # 5 times.

Rows 6 - 9: Knit in garter st in rows.

Row 10: BO 8 sts (I knitted st is already on the nd), * k6, BO 9 sts, repeat from * 4 times, kI4 (repeat = I5 sts).

Row II: BO 8 sts (I knitted st is already on the nd), k6, * CO 9 sts, k7, repeat from # 4 times, ending with CO 8 sts.

Row 12: Knit in garter st in rows, CO 8 sts at the end of row.

Rows 13 - 15: Knit in garter st in rows.

Knit Rows I - I5 once, then always repeat Rows 4 - I5.
