

Cowl "Shin Kyo Bridge" Design: Susanne Ederleh



Size: Circumference approx. 60 cm (23  $\frac{1}{2}$ "), 32 cm (12  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") high



Materials: XL Kleckse (100 % merino wool fine, superwash, yardage = 400 m (437 yds.)/100 g), color: 100 g "Shin Kyo Bridge" #2433, knitting needles 3 mm (US 2 ½)

# Difficulty

**KKK** difficult

easy intermediate Stockinette stitch: RS knit, WS purl.

I/I rib pattern: Alternate kI, pI; in WS rows knit sts as they appear.

## Stockinette stitch



# Gauge:

Gauge in stockinette stitch with needles 3 mm (US 2 1/2):

28 sts and 36 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm (4").;

10 sts in rib pattern: approx. 2.5 cm (I") wide

Stitch counter x 2.8 Row counter x 3.6

## Instructions:

CO 94 sts with knitting needles 3 mm (US 2 ½) and work in rows as follows: Edge st, 9 sts in rib pattern, starting with k1, p1, 74 sts in stockinette stitch st, 9 sts in rib pattern, starting with p1, k1, edge st. After 60 cm (23 ½") from CO edge BO all sts.

#### Finishing:

Block the piece and leave it under wet towels to dry. Sew the CO edge and the BO edge together.

Weave in all ends.
