



**Size:** Circumference approx. 60 cm (23 ½"), 32 cm (12 ½") high



**Materials:** XL Kleckse (100 % merino wool - fine, superwash, yardage = 400 m (437 yds.)/100 g), color: 100 g "Shin Kyo Bridge" #2433, knitting needles 3 mm (US 2 ½)

#### Difficulty

**Stockinette stitch:** RS knit, WS purl.

**I/I rib pattern:** Alternate k1, p1; in WS rows knit sts as they appear.

#### Stockinette stitch



#### Gauge:

**Gauge in stockinette stitch with needles 3 mm (US 2 ½):**

28 sts and 36 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4");

**10 sts in rib pattern:** approx. 2.5 cm (1") wide

**Stitch counter x 2.8**

**Row counter x 3.6**

#### Instructions:

CO 94 sts with knitting needles 3 mm (US 2 ½) and work in rows as follows: Edge st, 9 sts in rib pattern, starting with k1, p1, 74 sts in stockinette stitch st, 9 sts in rib pattern, starting with p1, k1, edge st. After 60 cm (23 ½") from CO edge BO all sts.

#### Finishing:

Block the piece and leave it under wet towels to dry. Sew the CO edge and the BO edge together.

Weave in all ends.
