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

**Maschenprobe im Lochmuster mit Nd Nr 4:** 24 M und 32 R = 10 x 10 cm.

**Größe: 36 - 42**

**Material:** 100g deine blauen Augen! Fb 2134 „**Lace Ball**“ (75% Schurwolle sw, 25% Polyamid, LL = 800m/100g), ein kleiner Rest (15g) oder 100g marine Fb 4201 „**Merino Lace**“ (57% Wolle, 23% Polyamid, 20% Mohair, LL = 400m/50g), Strick-Nd Nr 3,5 und Rundstrick-Nd Nr 4, 80 cm lang, eventuell Nd Nr 7 zum Abketten.


**Rippenmuster in Reihe:** 1 M re, 1 M li im Wechsel str.**kr re in R:** re M str.

**Lochmuster:** siehe Strickschrift. M-Zahl teilbar durch 18 + 4 Rdm. Es sind nur die Hin-R gez, in den Rück-R alle M und U li str. Die 1. bis 5. R stets wdh. In der Breite mit den M vor dem MS beginnen, den MS fortlaufend wdh, enden mit den M nach dem MS.



**Gauge:** 24 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in lace pattern on size 6/4 mm needles.

**Pattern:** CO 274 sts on size 4/3.5 mm needles with the Lace Ball. Knit 2 rows, then beg lace pattern according to the chart. Work 6 row pattern rep 26 times, ending with knit 2 rows. Using a larger needle, BO all sts very loosely.

**Finishing:** Dampen the garment, block and lay out to dry. With the Merino Lace and size 6/4 mm needles, pick up every 2nd st from the CO and BO rows, allowing the garment to form a circle. Join in the rnd. Work 20 rnds in ribbing. Then, using a larger needle (approx. US 10) BO all sts very loosely. Fold sleeves in half and seam closed. Weave in all ends.



**Size: 36-42**




**Materials:** 100g **deine blauen Augen!** col. 2134 "Lace Ball"  
(75% merino wool, 25% nylon, 800m/100g), 100g **marine** col.  
4201 "**Merino Lace**" (57% wool, 23% polyamide, 20% mohair,  
400m/50g), US size 4 needles and size 6 circular 32"/3.5 mm and  
4 mm, 80cm needles

**Rib st:** \* Kl, pl \* ; rep.

**Garter st:** Knit every row

**Lace pattern:** See chart. St count divisible by 18 + 4 selvedge sts.  
Only RS rows are given. On WS rows, p all sts including YO's. Rep rows 1-5.
