Felted Cape

Design: Barbara Roßner




To make: Using 6mm needles cast on 350 sts. Beg with a k row, work between edge sts in St st until all yarn has been knitted, leaving enough yarns to cast off. Cast off.

Finishing: Put scarf into a plastic bag add enough soapy water, in order to soak and close the bag. Place it in tumble dryer together with a wet towel, using warm temperature. When happy with the result stop the process. Be careful! Don't exceed 15% - 20% shrinkage in order to get soft scarf.

Abbreviations

beg	= beginning
k	= knit
p	= purl
RS	= right side
st(s)	= stitch(es)
St st	= Stockinette stitch (UK: stocking stitch)
WS	= wrong side

Difficulty

	easy

Finished size after felting: Approx 190 cm by 60 cm



Yarn: 600 gm Color 1659 ombre "Zauberwolle" (100 % Wool, length 250 m/100 gm), 6mm circular needles 120 cm long

St st – Stockinette Stitch: K in RS rows, p in WS rows.

Tension before felting: 19 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm, measured over St st using 6mm needles.
