

**Stockinette stitch**   **Reverse stockinette stitch**



**Gauge stockinette stitch with needle 30 mm:**

3 sts and 4 rds = 10 x 10 cm (4")

**Stitch counter x 0.3**

**Row counter x 0.4**

**Instructions:**

CO 26 sts on the circular needle and join for working in the rd, being careful not to twist. Mark the beg of rd with a contrasting yarn. Loosely knit 3 rds in reverse st st, then continue in st st rds. In the 4th st st rd knit tog the 1st and 2nd st and the 14th and 15th st = 24 sts. After 66 cm (26") from CO edge = 3 rds in reverse st st and 24 rds in st st continue as follows: BO 2 sts for the left armhole, k3, BO 4 sts for the front neckline, k3, BO 2 sts for the right armhole, k3, BO 4 sts for the back neckline, k3. Knit 6 rows in st st over the remaining 3 sts, then BO all 3 sts. Repeat this with the other 3x 3 sts and BO all sts.

**Finishing:**

Close shoulder seams and weave in all ends. Finish the armholes and neckline with 1 rd sc.



**Size: 36/38**



**Materials: 1500 g "Miss Wool"**

(100% merino wool, yardage = 50 m (54 yds.) / 500 g); color: **Off-White #980**, one 100 cm (40") circular needle 30 mm, one crochet hook 15 mm (C)

**Stockinette stitch in rds:** In rds, knit all sts. In rows, RS knit, WS purl.

**Reverse stockinette stitch in rds:** Purl all sts.
